4 lost hunters located in Hahns Peak area Monday night

Routt County Search and Rescue spent most of Monday looking for a group of three lost hunters in the Hahns Peak area.

One hunter who was separated from the group was located at about 3 p.m., Search and Rescue volunteer Kristia Check-Hill said.

Volunteers prepared snowmobiles to search for the remaining three hunters at about 6:30 p.m. Monday.

At about 7:15 p.m., volunteers located the three hunters and began working to get them back to camp.

Ikon Pass adds Chile's Valle Nevado, brings list to 37 resorts

Ikon passholders now have access to Valle Nevado in Chile, bringing the total number of Ikon resorts to 37 across four continents, according to a news release from Alterra Mountain Co.

The South American resort will offer seven days for Ikon Pass and five days for Ikon Base, with no blackout dates. Valle Nevado's season runs from June to September, allowing passholders to ski year-round.

"Now, Ikon Pass holders can extend their 2019 season by booking a trip to Chile for the legendary above-treeline

terrain in the Andes that Valle Nevado serves up," Alterra Chief Marketing Officer Erik Forsell was quoted as saying in the release. "South America is full of passionate skiers and riders who can also now take advantage of an endless winter with the Ikon Pass as they hit the slopes of North America during the 2018/2019 winter season."

The Ikon Pass, which was created in January, is a collaboration of Alterra, Aspen Skiing Co., Boyne, POWDR and independently owned ski areas.

Steamboat skiers and snowboarders have the option of unlimited Steamboat Resort access on the Ikon Pass for \$1,049 or five restricted days at Steamboat Resort on the Ikon Base Pass for \$749. The Ikon Base Pass is blacked out from Dec. 26 to 31, Jan. 19 and 20 and Feb. 16 and 17. Both pass options include access to additional resorts.
